



Christian - Duncan and Robin Banks - Rhonda








Christian: Hi. How are you doing?" Robin Banks: "Fine. How are you?" Christian: "Good, thanks. Mind if I ask a question? Do you know of any good churches in this area? Robin Banks: "I don't know. I haven't been to church for years." Christian: "Do you have a Christian background?" Robin Banks: "Yes. I went to Sunday school, but grew out of it when I got older." Christian: "By the way, my name's Christian. What's yours?" Robin Banks: "Robin Banks." Christian: "Nice to meet you, Robin. Would you consider yourself to be a good person... I mean, do you think you've kept the Ten Commandments?" Robin Banks: "Pretty much." Christian: "Have you you ever told a lie?" Robin Banks: "Yes." Christian: "What does that make you?" Robin Banks: "A liar."

Christian: "Have you ever stolen something?" Robin Banks: "I know what you're doing. You're laying a guilt trip on me. Christian: "Really? Which Commandment makes you feel guilty-You shall not lie'?" Robin Banks: "No." Christian: "You shall not steal?" Robin Banks: "Um...I really don't want to talk about this anymore." Christian: "I'm sorry. I didn't mean to offend you. What do you do for a living, Robin?" Robin Banks: "I... um...I work in a bank. I've got to go now..."

Never be discouraged if someone suddenly wants to end a conversation. If the person feels guilty as you go through the Commandments, it's probably because he/she is guilty. The Law has that effect on sinners. You may not be aware of the fear and concern that grips the heart of someone you are witnessing to, but agitation or frustration is a good sign that something is going on in the heart.



Lets review the "Break Out of Your Comfort Zone assignments with the group and commit together to completing them before the next session. Engaging in these activities is critical for all to experience the growth we are looking for. Don't chicken out!

1. At-Home-Preparation: Stand in front of a mirror. Make sure no one is around or can hear you. Look directly at your image and ask a friendly, "How are you doing?" Of course, you are going to feel a little foolish, but no one is watching except God. Then ask, "Did you get one of these?" Offer your reflection a tract, saying, "It's a gospel tract. Do you have a Christian background?" Then inquire, "What do you think happened after someone dies? Do you believe in heaven and hell?" Continue asking these questions until you shake off any self consciousness. Get used to the sound of your own voice. Remember, you've not a weirdo and you don't sound like one. You are a warm and friendly Christian who genuinely cares about people. Keep practicing saying these things until it feels natural. If you don't feel comfortable doing this, repeat it again and again until you do.

2. Real-World Application: Carry tracts with you as you go through the week, leaving tracts where people will find them. Get creative. Discreetly, in grocery baskets, trolleys, public toilets, shop, etc. Pray as you do it and then as you lay your head on your pillow at night, there will be a deep sense of satisfaction knowing that you're planting seeds that could result in someone finding everlasting life. The Way of the Master gives light to an almost forgotten biblical key that has the power to unlock the door of the human heart. This is the proven and effective way of making the gospel make sense to the unsaved. It is so rooted in the Scriptures that once you see it, you will forever wonder how you could have missed it. It is the biblical principle of bypassing the intellect (the place of argument) and speaking directly to the conscience (the place of the knowledge of right and wrong)—the way Jesus did. Jesus was not afraid to shake people up. He spoke openly of their sinful nature and the righteousness of God. He forced people to confront their sin head-on, and He brought them face-to-face with their need for salvation-because He loved them

Lesson 3

The at-home-assignments will prepare you for taking the next step - applying what you're learning in the real world.

- 1. At-Home-Preparation: Stand in front of a mirror. Make sure no one is around or can hear you. Look directly at your image and ask a friendly, "How are you doing?"
